50 Shades of Sweaters – Cori Eichelberger (\$45)

This workshop will give you a chance to look at construction styles of 60 sweaters; you will really visually “see” what you may like or dislike about a sweater pattern. Cori will give you ideas for things you've never heard of doing to get a sweater to fit you superbly. She will show you why some sweaters look great on everyone and talk about why some sweaters will never fit anyone well, even though we love the look of them.



Novelty Cables Olga Buraya-Kefelian (\$80)

We all love the look of cabled knits but some of them can be quite complex to execute! In this class you will be presented with five other novel options of creating cables using other than the traditional technique.

This class is part demonstration with AV presentation and lecture about 3D knitwear in hand knitting approach and all inspiration process. Olga presents her 3D design philosophy, to reveal a slightly different angle of knitwear and putting your existing knitting skills into a novel path.

Skills needed: knit, purl, cast on, bind off, increase, decrease



50 Shades of Shawls Cori Eichelberger (\$45)

This is your chance to take a look at the world of knitted shawls, from different constructions to yarn choices, color choices as well as styling options. Anything you wear around your neck will be modeled and discussed with tips and tricks to make your shawl knitting a must have!

Rag Rug Weaving Workshop – Constance Hall (\$110)

Learn how to weave with fabric, rag rugs, or t-shirts on your rigid heddle loom. There are tricks and tips that will help you and your loom weave many projects with fabric: placemats, coasters, rugs, clothing! In this class we will warp and weave a placemat, learning all the tips that will make your future projects successful. We will have fun and learn in a step-by-step way, leaving no weaver behind!
