

January 2019 Class Schedule

Basic Mittens: Keep your hands cozy in these snazzy mittens! Students will learn to how knit mittens in the round on double pointed needles and how to shape the thumb gusset.

Beginner Knit Hat: Learn to knit in the round while making this fantastic hat! Perfect for your second class, this simple hat can be made as a beanie or a slouchy hat and is sized from infant to large adult.

Beginner Knit Socks: Learn to knit the coziest thing in the history of the world – hand knit socks! In this class students will learn all the techniques needed to knit top down socks, including how to knit in the round on double pointed needles, how to work a heel flap, how to work a short row heel, pick up stitches and how to work Kitchener (grafting) stitch. You will be making a baby sock in class and doing an adult sock on your own during this class.

Beginner Preventing & Fixing Mistakes: Ever get to the end of a row and find you are short a stitch or two, or that you have too many stitches, or that holes have inexplicably appeared in your knitting? Maybe your stitches are looking a little wonky and you just don't know how to fix them. Then this class is perfect for the beginner knitter. Learn what common mistakes we all make while knitting and, more importantly, how to fix them.

Beginning Brioche Cowl: Get a taste of 2-color brioche in the round with this cowl class. This is a great introduction to the brioche technique that is so popular now. Worked up in bulky yarn, this cowl is perfect for a quick gift to keep your recipient warm and cozy during the cold winter months.

Beginning Knitting: Learn the basics with this two-part class! Students will learn how to cast on, the knit & purl stitch, how to work knit and purl stitches in the same row, and how to read a pattern. We will work toward knitting your first project, the Wheat Scarf by Tin Can Knits!

Beloved Bonnet: This sweet little hat has such a FUN AND unique construction, it's knit with a combination of DPNs and either straight or circular needles (your choice), but it's knit completely flat! The hat can be knit in sizes from newborn all the way up to Adult. You'll learn lots of little tips and tricks in class including German Short Rows, I-cords, increases and decreases. The style is reminiscent of Anna's hat from the movie Frozen, which is my Granddaughters' favorite! This is a two-week class.

Brioche Brim Hat: Create this simple and warm hat with a brioche brim! This hat is a stylish starter project for trying out brioche. Worked in the round with worsted or chunky yarns, this two-color project is a fast knit!

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Crochet Woodpile Mittens: Have you taken our Beginner Hat Class and want to try making a set of mittens to match? Or would you just like to learn how to make mittens for any size of hands using any gauge of yarn? Then join us for the Woodpile Mittens class! This class takes your skills beyond the basic hat to further learn shaping, seaming, working in the round, and finishing, and you'll have a pattern that will allow you to make mittens for the tiniest frost sprites up to big hairy yetis.

Helix Hat: Pull out all your worsted-weight scraps and knit them together in helix stripes. These stash-busting hats are a fun, easy way to use up even the smallest bits of stash.

Choose at least three colors. If you run out of one along the way just tie on another and keep knitting! No Stash? Just choose any odd number of worsted weight yarns to make your jogless striped hat.

Intro to Crochet: Ready to proudly tell your friends that you're a hooker? Whether you've been a knitter for years or have never picked up needles or a hook, in this two-part class you will learn the slip knot cast on, chain stitch, and single crochet; different hook styles and which will work best for you; the slip stitch, half-double crochet, and double crochet; and how to read a crochet pattern by getting to know stitch abbreviations and following a pattern to make a granny square with Terri or a sampler square with Jessica.

***Open Sweater Study:** Knit the sweater of your choice in Open Sweater Study! Pick any sweater, any construction, any size, as simple or complex as you like. This class is designed to be flexible to suit the student's needs with help on certain skills (like fitting and bust darts) and more. This class is for the student to get support and instruction on whatever area they need help with at that moment. Sign up for as many or as few classes as you need.

Windowpane Crochet Scarf: The Windowpane is the perfect fall scarf to keep the chill off your neck without being bulky. The crocheted pattern works up quickly and the pattern is easily memorized. The scarf will show off variegated, gradient or striping yarns and can be made long, shorter, wider, etc. with just a little bit of preplanning. This is not a beginner class, but it is a good step up from beginner crochet. You'll learn everything in just one class and leave with the knowledge to complete your scarf on your own!

Woodland Mittens: These beautifully textured mitts can be worked as fingerless or full mittens. Beginning with a scalloped cuff, these mitts use creative patterning, garter stitch, and ribbing. Show off the variegation in your favorite hand-dyed yarn or highlight the beauty of a semi-solid.

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Class pricing and policies

Classes are \$10 per hour plus supplies unless specified; length of class is dependent upon the complexity of the subject. All classes are two hours and up. You can purchase classes individually or apply package credit. The price and length each class will be clearly defined in the class description.

Packages of class hours are available at \$100 per 10 hours, which includes 10 hours of instruction plus one 10% off coupon for supplies and one voucher for a one-hour Knit/Crochet/Spin Doctor session.

Classes have a minimum of 3 students and maximum of 6 to 12 students, depending on the complexity of the subject.

The Knit/Crochet Doctor sessions are \$15 per half hour and are available several times during the month; times are on the calendar. Get the help you need with a tricky stitch sequence, an unclear pattern, a runaway dropped stitch, or any other knitting, crocheting or spinning challenge. Call to schedule a session.

Private tutoring sessions are \$25 per hour.
