

June 2023 Class Schedule



Basic Mittens: This is the ultimate beginner level mitten pattern. Learn to knit in the round on DPNS while knitting up a pair of the "Worlds Simplest Mittens". This basic pattern is a go to for a quick gift or as a blank canvas to design your own mittens. This pattern will also serve as an introduction to simple shaping in knitting using increases and decreases. We will knit a child size mitten in class. **Pre-requisite Skills:** Basic knitting skills required including cast on, knit and purl combinations (ribbing). Working in the round and familiarity with double pointed needles such as the top of a hat helpful.

Beginning Crochet: Crochet is hotter than ever! Whether you have never picked up a hook or are a knitter looking to expand your skill set, this class is for you. In this introduction to crochet, students will learn the basics, from creating a chain stitch to essential stitches like single crochet, double crochet, half double crochet, and triple crochet. This class will give students the foundational knowledge to create basic crochet projects. You will start to create a small project.

Beginning Knit: Knitting is now more popular than ever, and you can learn too! In this 2-part class, students will learn how to cast on, the knit & purl stitch, knit and purl combination stitches in the same row, and how to read a pattern. During the second class, you will learn how to shop for and start your first project, the Wheat Scarf by Tin Can Knits. **No Pre-requisite Skills Required!**

Beginning Rigid Heddle Weaving: Ever wanted to try weaving? Learn how to make woven fabric on a super portable, super approachable, super affordable rigid heddle loom! In the morning, we will learn common weaving terms (including the parts of the loom), how to direct-warp a loom using a warping peg, how to thread your loom, and how to weave fabric. In the afternoon, we will finish weaving and cover finishing techniques including knotting and trimming fringe, and wet finishing your woven fabric. Students will leave with a set of coasters to felt at home. **No Pre-requisite Skills Required!**

Building Blocks 6: If you have learned the basics of knitting (casting on, binding off) and want to steadily improve your skills then come join the Building Blocks of Skill series of classes. This is one of Michelle Hunter's most popular Building Block series. It is designed to move you from a beginner to an intermediate level knitter. Each class will focus on a different skill that every knitter should have in their repertoire. Attend every class and you will have 12 squares that you can stitch together into a beautiful afghan. **Pre-requisite Skills:** Knowledge of basic knitting stitches. All other stitches will be taught in class.

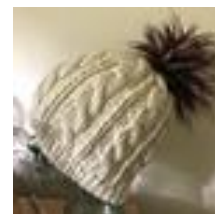

Bulky Cable Hat: Do cables have you scared? If you can knit and purl, you can make this cute bulky cabled hat. It's a quick knit, with a written pattern, no charts! **Pre-requisite Skills:** Basic knitting skills such as knit, purl and knit/ purl combinations. Experience with knitting in the round and basic decreases are helpful.

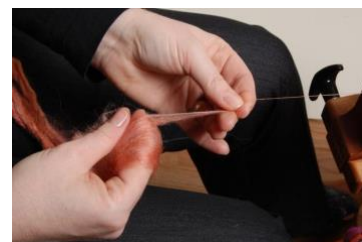

Crochet Virus Shawl: Take your beginning crochet skills to the next level! The Virus shawl is a beautiful shawl with only 4 repeating rounds. In this class you will also learn to read crochet chart patterns although the written version will be supplied too. Super easy pattern + beautiful long striping yarn = one beautiful creation! **Pre-requisite Skills:** Must know basic crochet stitches such as chain, single and double crochet. Don't be intimidated by this project ... it's super easy!

Drafting: Short, Long and In-between: Have you heard of spinning long draw? What about short draw? From the fold? What about pre-drafting? Attenuating? Stripping your fiber? How you pre-draft, prepare and draft your fiber makes a huge difference in your experience while you spin AND the character of your finished yarn. We will talk about short forward & backward drafts, long draw (including attenuated long draw), and spinning from the fold. We will also talk about the how and why of pre-drafting and stripping your fiber before you spin it. **Pre-requisite Skills:** Skill level - advanced beginner: Students should have beginning spinning instruction before taking this class. Students must be able to spin a continuous strand of yarn on their chosen equipment without difficulty.

***New* Easy Dyeing at Home with Tinctures:** Are you curious about how the whole yarn dyeing process works? We found an innovative way to dye at home that's quick and super easy by using dye tinctures and very hot water. Sarah & Andrea will teach you how at the studio and then you can bring supplies home to dye on your own. This process is for protein fibers like wool and alpaca. With several naked yarns and 25 colors to choose from, you will come home with a special skeins you dyed yourself. **Pre-requisite Skills: None needed**

***New* Garter Snake Hat:** Introduction to 2 color brioche – combined with garter stitch in the round this makes a fun geometric design. This is a quick knit, beanie style hat. **Pre-requisite Skills:** Knit, purl, cast on, experience with knitting in the round on a hat and decreases.

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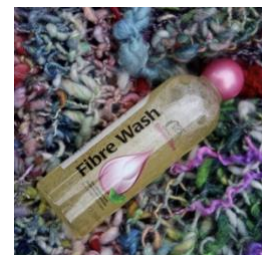


***New* My First Mosaic Cap:** Learn an easy way to add color to your project with the mosaic technique in this class. This pattern is a perfect dive into new stitches after you have already made a plain hat or two. You only work one color per row and let the slip stitches do all the work! **Pre-requisite Skills:** Knit, purl, cast on, and knitting in the round on a hat is a must.

Wet Finishing Handspun Yarn & Woven Fabrics: If you've spent any time around spinners or weavers, you have likely heard one say, "It's not finished until it's WET FINISHED." What is wet finishing? Why is it important? Is that another word for felting? How does one do it? We will answer all those questions and more in this class! **Pre-requisite Skills:** Crafters need to have spun a bobbin of yarn (plied or singles) that will hold together when unwound from bobbin OR have handwoven fabric removed from the loom.

Class pricing and policies

Classes are \$15 per hour plus supplies unless specified; length of class is dependent upon the complexity of the subject. All classes are two hours and up. You can purchase classes individually or apply package credit. The price and length each class will be clearly defined in the class description.

Packages of class hours are available at \$150 per 10 hours, which includes 10 hours of instruction plus one 10% off coupon for supplies and one voucher for a one-hour Knit/Crochet/Spin Doctor session.

Most classes have a minimum of 2 students and maximum of 4 students, depending on the complexity of the subject. **Cancellations must be 48 in advance to receive a credit for your class.** We understand emergencies happen and we certainly don't want you to come in when you are ill, but please let us know as soon as possible.

The Private Tutoring Lessons are \$25 per hour. Knit/Crochet Doctor sessions are \$15 per half hour and are available to get the help you need with a tricky stitch sequence, an unclear pattern, a runaway dropped stitch, or any other knitting, crocheting or spinning challenge.
