

## May 2024 Class Schedule



**Beginning Crochet:** Crochet is hotter than ever! Whether you have never picked up a hook or are a knitter looking to expand your skill set, this class is for you. In this introduction to crochet, students will learn the basics, from creating a chain stitch to essential stitches like single crochet, double crochet, half double crochet, and triple crochet. This class will give students the foundational knowledge to create basic crochet projects. You will start to create a small project.

**Beginning Knit:** Knitting is now more popular than ever, and you can learn too! In this 2-part class, students will learn how to cast on, the knit & purl stitch, knit and purl combination stitches in the same row, and how to read a pattern. During the second class, you will learn how to shop for and start your first project, the Wheat Scarf by Tin Can Knits.

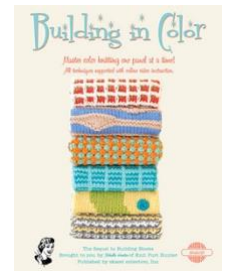
**Beginning Tapestry Weaving:** Have you always wanted to learn to weave, but aren't ready to commit to a loom yet? Do you have limited crafting space and need to be able to hide your weaving away when you aren't working on it?

Tapestry weaving on a frame loom is the perfect way to dip your toe into weaving without affecting the footprint of your living space! In this class, we will weave a mug rug on a small frame loom as a way to learn how to warp a frame loom, how to weave weft-faced fabric, how to secure your weaving and finish your tapestry! **Pre-requisite Skills:** None

**Building Blocks in Color 4:** Master color knitting one panel at a time! Building in Color is a carefully designed sequence of patterns aimed at introducing knitters to the wonderful array of stitches and techniques used in color knitting. This is the sequel to the Building Blocks book by Michelle Hunter. Attend every class and you will have 10 sections that you can stitch together into a beautiful blanket. **Pre-requisite Skills:** Knowledge of basic knitting stitches. All other stitches will be taught in class. Please knit a gauge swatch in your selected yarn **before** your first class.

**\*New\* Foundation Crochet:** Looking for an easy, stretchy way to start your larger crochet projects? Foundation crochet eliminates the need for a long chain cast-on and makes the chain and starting row all at the same time! In this class you'll learn Single Foundation Crochet, Half-Double Foundation Crochet and Double Foundation Crochet Basics. **Pre-requisite Skills:** Basic crochet skills are required. You should know how to make a slipstitch, chain, single crochet, half-double crochet and double crochet. Being able to read your stitches is helpful, but not required.

**Plying:** After you've learned the ins and outs of your wheel and how to spin a continuous single, the next step is to ply your yarn. Multi-ply yarn is more stable and balanced yarn, as well as longer-wearing.

In this class, we will cover how to make a traditional 2-ply yarn, traditional and chain-plied 3-ply yarns and more. We will also talk about how to best prepare your singles for plying, why you need a lazy kate, how to construct your own lazy kate on the cheap, and what to do if you \*gasp\* ply your yarn in the wrong direction.

**Pre-requisite Skills:** Skill level - advanced beginner: Students should have beginning spinning instruction before taking this class. Students must be able to spin a continuous strand of yarn on their chosen equipment without difficulty.

**Tunisian Dragon Tail:** This versatile, Tunisian Crochet Dragon Tail can be used as a shawl, a wrap or a scarf. In this one-week class, you'll learn the basics of Tunisian Crochet along with a modified stitch that prevents curling as well as increases and binding off. This fun pattern is a repeat of just 10 rows! The original pattern, designed by your teacher, is included in class but is easily memorized, and you'll be Dragon Tailing without it in no time! **Pre-requisite Skills:** Should be proficient making a chain stitch, single crochet.

## Class pricing and policies

Classes are \$15 per hour plus supplies unless specified; length of class is dependent upon the complexity of the subject. All classes are two hours and up. You can purchase classes individually or apply package credit. The price and length each class will be clearly defined in the class description.

Packages of class hours are available at \$150 per 10 hours, which includes 10 hours of instruction plus one 10% off coupon for supplies and one voucher for a one-hour Knit/Crochet/Spin Doctor session.

Most classes have a minimum of 2 students and maximum of 4 students, depending on the complexity of the subject. **Cancellations must be 48 in advance to receive a credit for your class.** We understand emergencies happen and we certainly don't want you to come in when you are ill, but please let us know as soon as possible.

The Private Tutoring Lessons are \$25 per hour. Knit/Crochet Doctor sessions are \$15 per half hour and are available to get the help you need with a tricky stitch sequence, an unclear pattern, a runaway dropped stitch, or any other knitting, crocheting or spinning challenge.
